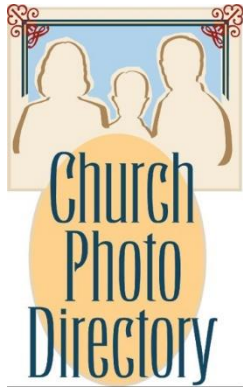

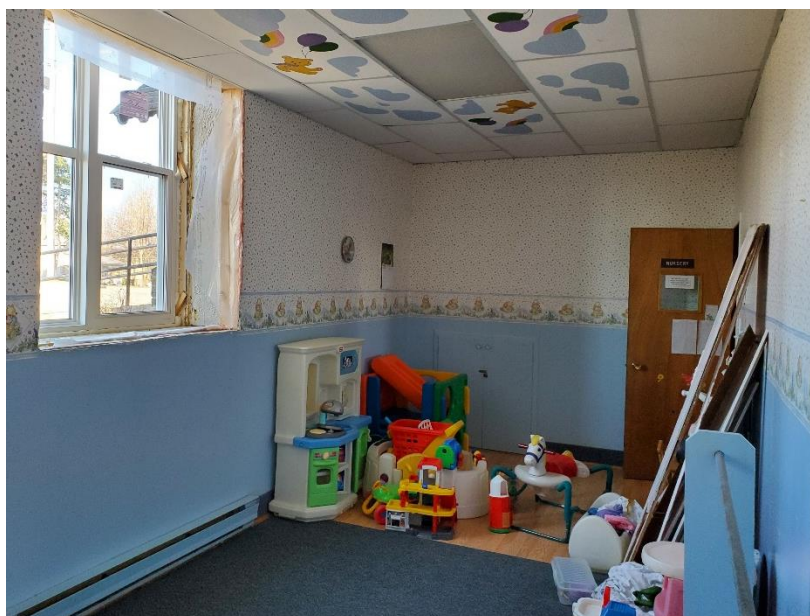

**\$402,000 has been raised by the United Church for Ukraine Relief, with \$240,000 already sent through Action by Churches Together (ACT).**

**Plans are being finalized for disbursing the remaining \$162,000 and the funds that continue to be donated.**
