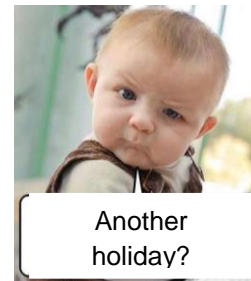
To ensure a smooth delivery for paper & email receipts, we need to ensure your contact information is correct.

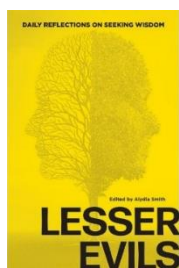


ANNUAL MEETING

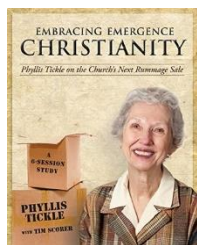
LENTEN DEVOTIONAL BOOKLETS
