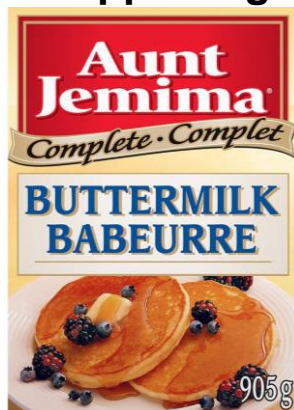
SERVICE OF PRAYERS FOR HEALING - SUNDAY, JAN. 23rd AT 7P.M.

Supporting our Local Food Bank with a Special Meal

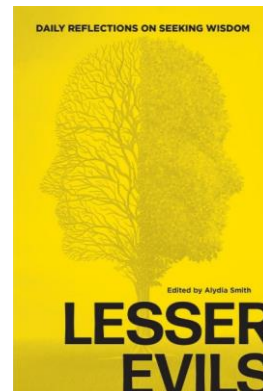
