**Masks are required to be worn in the Office.**

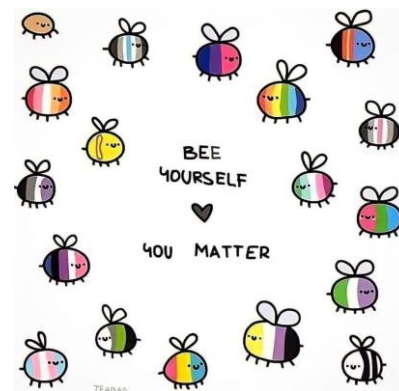
Otherwise, until further notice, you may choose whether or not to wear a mask. Please respect the choices of others.

## SERVICE OF PRAYERS WITH THE MUSIC OF TAIZÉ

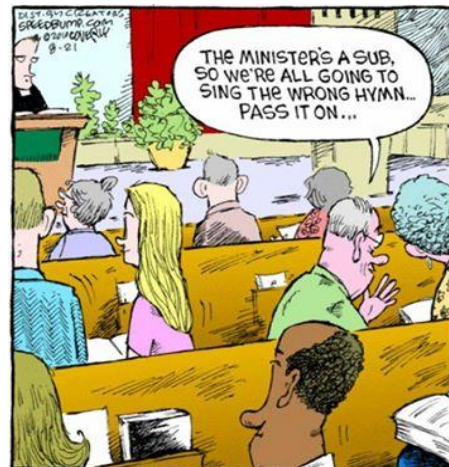

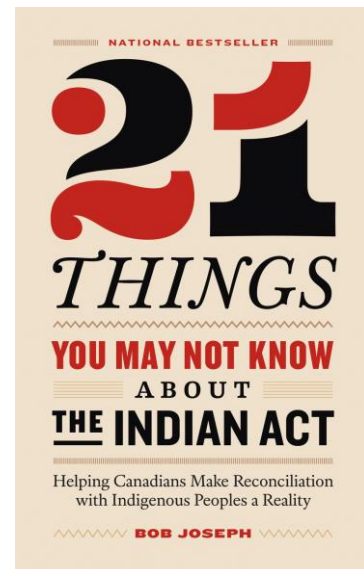
