## ONLINE TOY & HAMPER DRIVE RUNS UNTIL NOV. 20TH

Bruce Power has launched its annual on-line fund-raiser with the goal of raising more than \$40,000 in cash donations for community toy drives and hamper programs this holiday season.

[The fund-raiser](#), organized in conjunction with the United Way of Bruce Grey, is open to employees, supplier partners, and the public, and will provide a boost for numerous local organizations, including:

- Kincardine Community Services, St. Anthony's Catholic Church, Ripley Lions & Tiverton Lions, Huron County Christmas Bureau
- Chippewas of Nawash Unceded First Nation & Saugeen First Nation
- Paisley Missionary Church, Port Elgin Salvation Army, United Way Grey County
- Women's shelters in Bruce, Grey and Huron counties

If the original goal of \$40,000 is exceeded, Bruce Power and the United Way will distribute the extra funds accordingly.

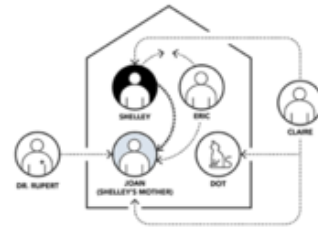

A Care Map is a simple diagram of the people involved in providing care to a caregiver and care recipient. It includes family, friends, and healthcare professionals who may provide assistance or support, however big or small.

A Care Map is a simple tool to identify the people and services involved in your support network. It also helps you to understand the role(s) those people and services play for you and each other.
