GENEROSITY IN OUR CHANGED TIMES

For over 18 months we have lived the reality of this pandemic. Church life is forever changed. While we have carefully returned to in-person worship, we still live-stream. Potluck dinners are a fond memory, masking a common practice, and we are still limited in what we can do within the building. All of this is because we are looking out for one another, keeping each other safe and well.

Yet, our mission is ever present. Those isolated at home are contacted regularly. The new automatic door buttons are installed. The lights in the sanctuary are replaced with energy-efficient LED bulbs, the fans have been cleaned and the new heat pumps worked well this summer. Meetings work well on Zoom while the choir is slowly regaining their repertoire. Funerals are now commonly at the graveside while weddings are more commonly celebrated outside. The Tech Crew continues to make the magic happen. Our giving hearts continue to welcome on another in new ways.
